The audience included parents, students, teachers and dignitaries and guests from Wingecarribee Shire Council (including the Mayor) and In2Uni Representatives from our





project learning partner the University of Wollongong. Choc tops and popcorn were enjoyed alongside the films - with each class presenting a film about their learning projects and experiences in their first year of high school. Fourteen 'Oscars' were awarded on the night, along with 30 certificates of acknowledgement and 7 class trophies. It was a fabulous celebration of the wonderful achievements of Year 7.

The night also featured three Year 8 Films – the work of the school's partnership with the Youth Hub and local actor and film maker, Vincent McManus.
